***Rainforest Adventure*** is a multisensory expedition that introduces visitors to tropical rainforests around the world, highlights the challenges facing these unique ecological wonders and suggests ways that people can make a difference.

### **H.E.R.O. (Helping Earth's Rainforest Organization) Base Camp**

Gear up for your adventure! Put on a research assistant vest, grab your assignment and tools and visit one of the scientist stations to discover what rainforest scientists do. Get a close-up view of plants and materials through an oversized microscope. Learn more about the rainforest in field guides and a selection of books.

### **Wonders of the Rainforest**

Discover a 9-foot tall kapok tree, peek at the life in a bromeliad or the leaf litter and climb into the rainforest canopy using a chair lift. Create your own unique insect that lives in the rainforest.

### **Travel the World**

Visit four very different rainforest regions around the world: Latin America, Southeast Asia, Australia and Africa. Visit a village, weave on a loom and learn about local customs and traditions. Save the tigers! Build a web of life and learn about the interconnection between plants and animals. Learn about the forest floor and crawl through a tree log to discover animals that make their homes there. Study gorillas and get cozy in a gorilla's nest. Discover products that come from tropical rainforests. Visit children around the world and learn how their families help protect the rainforests.
